

2023 Salmon Arm Downtown Live

**** Performance time for the 2023 season is: 11:00 am - 1:30 pm, 2 hours playtime with 30 minutes of break, unless otherwise specified.**

**** Artist payment is negotiable, solo performance beginning at \$150.**

Downtown Salmon Arm will provide performer(s) with:

- Performance area (Ross Street Stage),
- Access to electricity and power cord
- Please be aware that we do not have a secure (i.e., locked) location to store instruments during the performance break. Arrangements will need to be made with Market Coordinator if you chose to leave the site.
- Performers will receive their honorarium upon the completion of the performance via e-transfer. If you require a physical cheque, please let us know asap.

Performer(s) will provide:

- All performers will provide and set up their own sound system
- All performers must be at Alexander Plaza for set up a minimum of 1/2 hr before the scheduled performance time - you may arrive sooner if additional setup time is required.
- Each group is required to set up and clean up their own equipment

WEATHER + SMOKE POLICY

If weather or smoke is forecasted to be extreme on any given Saturday, a decision will be made to cancel Alexander Plaza. If the decision is made 36 hours prior to the event (10:30am Thursday) no cancellation fee will be paid.

If the decision is made to cancel after 36 hours and up until 2 hours before the scheduled performance a cancellation fee of 50% of the performance fee will be paid to the performing artist/group in these circumstances.

If the weather or smoke is doubtful (i.e.: raining occasionally or threatening), the decision regarding cancellation will be made by the Market Coordinator. This decision will be made at the stage **NO EARLIER THAN 45 minutes** before the scheduled performance. If the concert is cancelled at this time or, if setting up proceeds but it is decided to cancel before the beginning of the concert, a cancellation fee of 75% will be paid to performers

If all performers are not present 30 minutes prior to stage time when the decision to cancel is made, the nominal cancellation fee will not be paid.

If cancellation occurs during the concert, the full performance fee will be paid.

Liability and Insurance:

a) All performer(s) shall hold harmless: The City of Salmon Arm, Downtown Salmon Arm Improvement Association (DSA), DSA employees, or volunteers free from liability for any damages to or loss of performance equipment used in performances under this agreement. Performance equipment includes any physical object(s) rented, borrowed, owned, or otherwise obtained for use in their performance. The performer(s) recognizes their responsibility to provide insurance for any equipment used under this agreement. b) The performer(s) shall also hold The City of Salmon Arm and DSA free from liability for any personal injury (including death) or property damage associated with their performance under this agreement. The performer(s) recognizes their responsibility to provide adequate insurance policies to cover such an eventuality.

The performer(s) shall also hold The City of Salmon Arm and Salmon Arm Downtown Improvement Association free from and against any and all suits or claims alleging damage or injury (including death) to any person or property that may occur or be alleged to have occurred in the course of the performances and, at its own expense, the performer(s) shall defend any and all such actions and pay all legal charges and other costs arising.

If circumstances shall arise that are not covered by the above clauses, the performer(s) acknowledges responsibility for all their own insurance and liability, as well as any responsibility that may be associated with them or their performance equipment under this agreement.

Salmon Arm Downtown Improvement Association reserves the right to cancel this agreement. DSA reserves the right to halt a contracted performance at any time, during any performance. Under this agreement, **the performer agrees to conduct themselves in a manner that will promote a FAMILY-ORIENTED ENVIRONMENT.** This includes abstaining from alcohol or other substances while performing, refraining from using coarse language, and playing inappropriate music. Such behaviour waives the performer(s) right to continue participation in the Downtown Salmon Arm Downtown Live Program.

Agreement to the Above Conditions

The performer(s) and Salmon Arm Downtown Improvement Association agree to the conditions detailed above concerning the contracted performance for the Downtown Salmon Arm Downtown Live at the time(s), date(s) and location(s) listed above.
